- *Web contact area* – Address of the coordinator responsible for the web design.

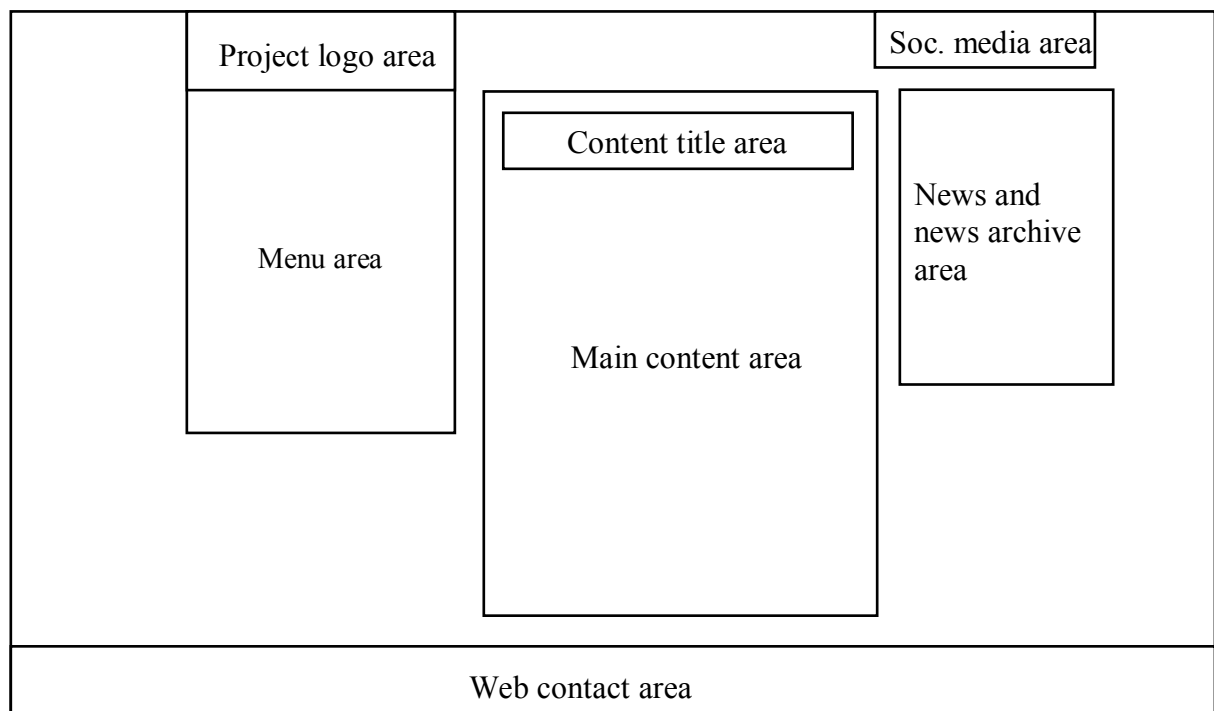


Fig. 1. General site layout

Also, the BASTION web site is equipped with a *favicon.ico* icon for easy and visual web site recognition in the bookmarks and while navigating through several browser tabs.

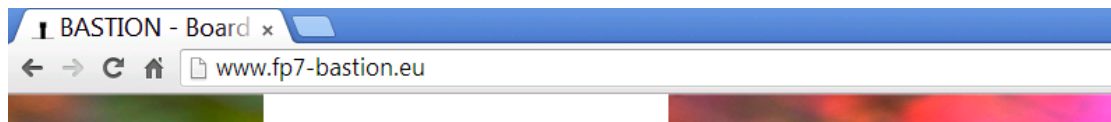


Fig. 2. Favicon usage in tab identification

This page provides general information about the BASTION project.

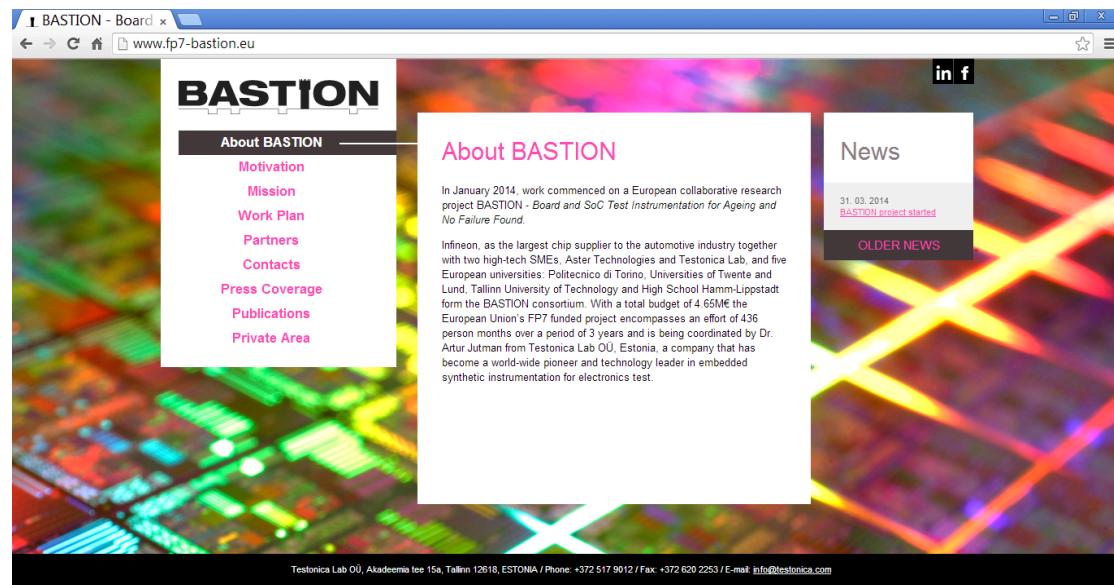


Fig. 3. The About BASTION page

This page outlines the project motivation.

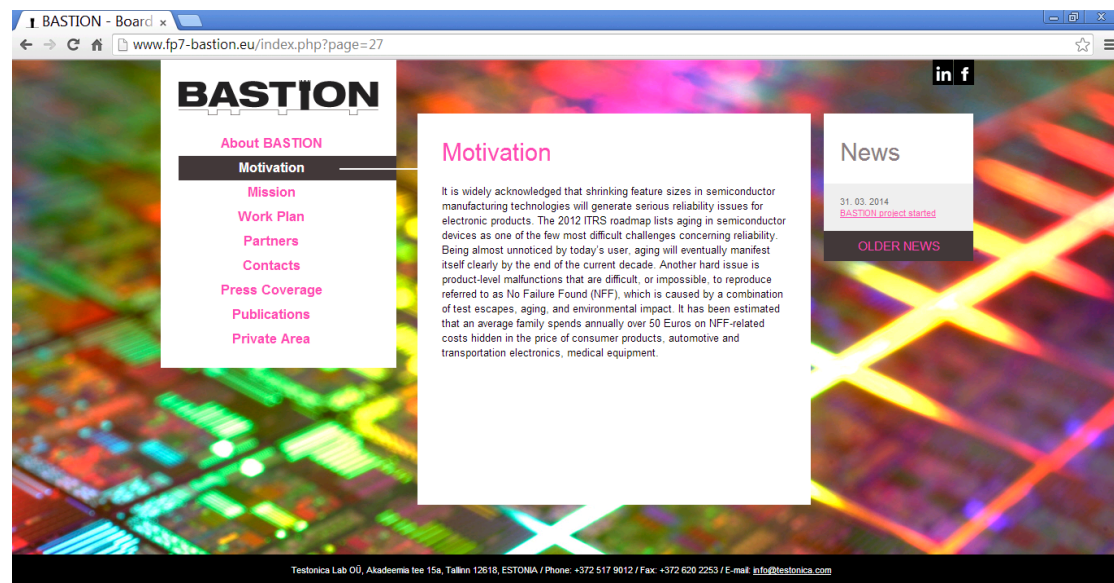


Fig. 4. The Motivation page

This page presents the mission and aim of the BASTION project.



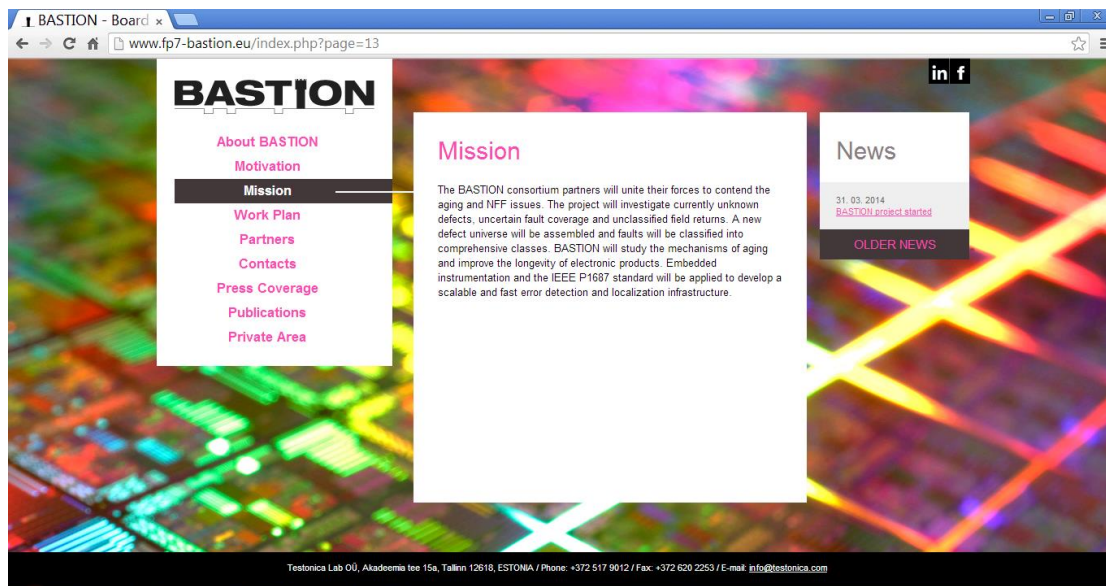


Fig. 5. The Mission page

This page represents the work plan of the BASTION project and explains how different work packages jointly contribute to the project objectives.

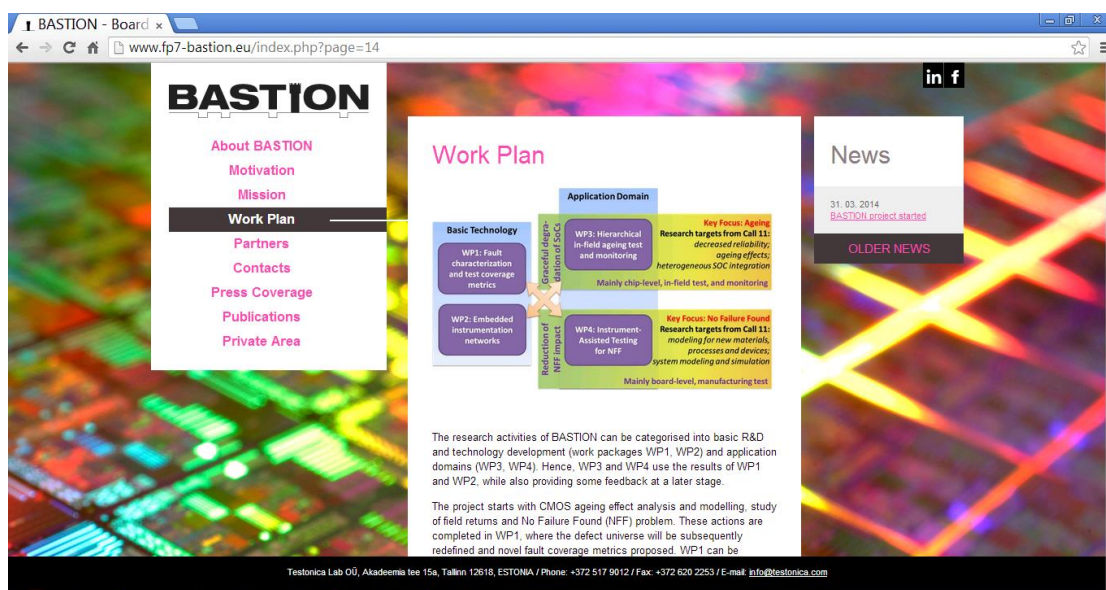


Fig. 6. The Work Plan page

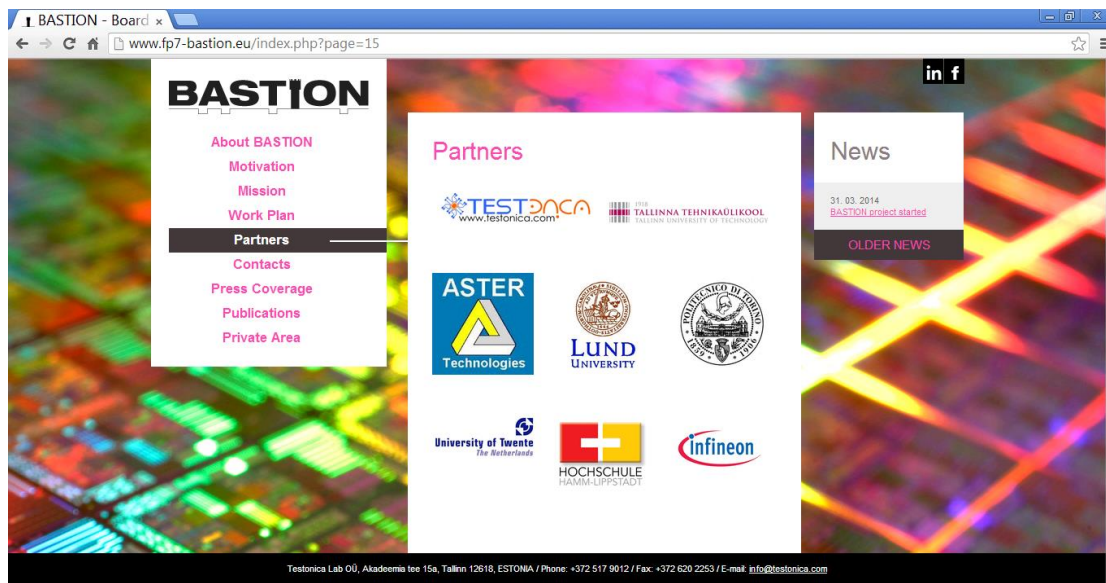


Fig. 7. The Partners page

This page provides the main contact persons and data for each of the beneficiary in the BASTION project.

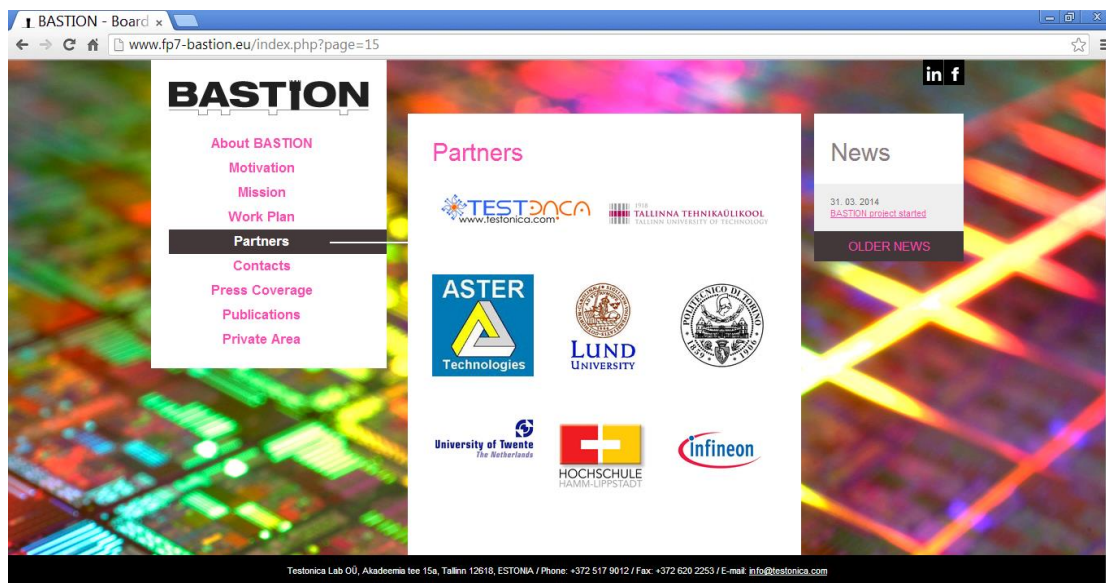


Fig. 8. The Contacts page

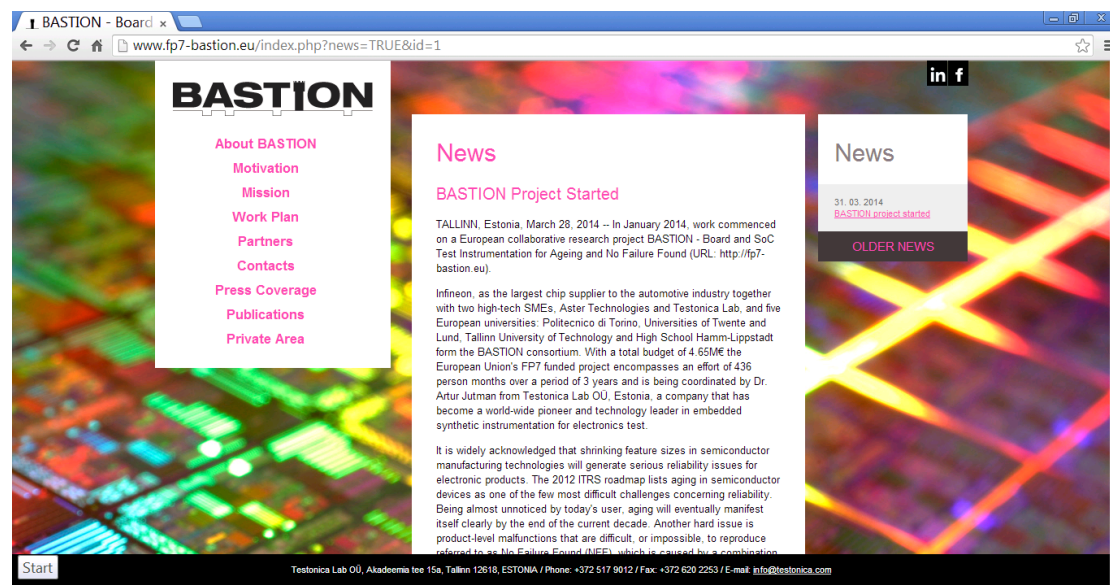


Fig. 9. The News page

This is the default error page for unavailable or restricted resources on the <http://fp7-BASTION.eu/> domain.



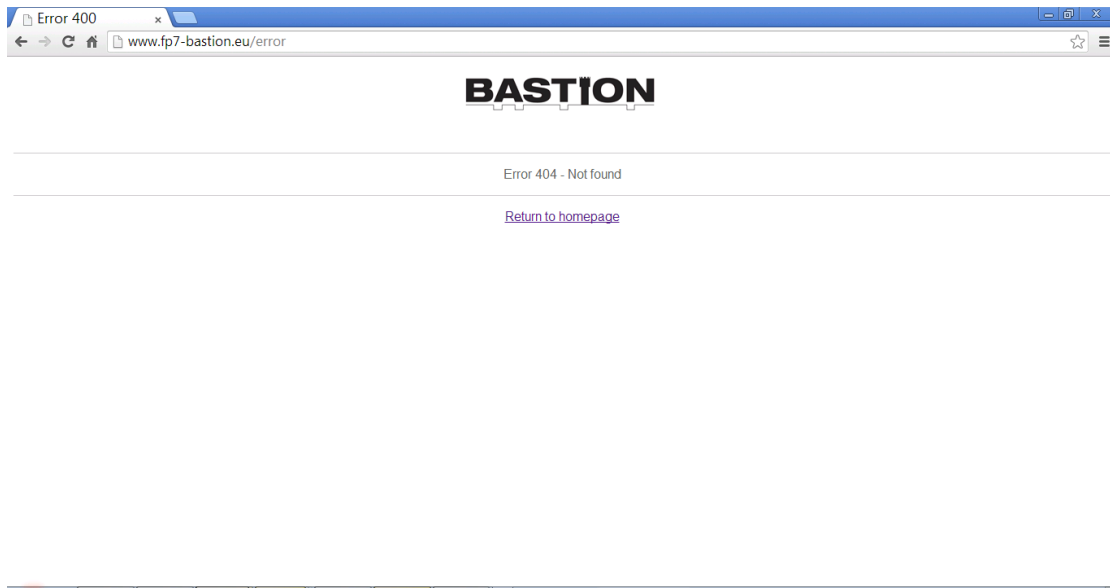


Fig. 10. Appearance of the Error page. Error 404.

In addition, BASTION social media groups have been set up in LinkedIn and Facebook. These groups are accessible from the social media area of the BASTION home page.

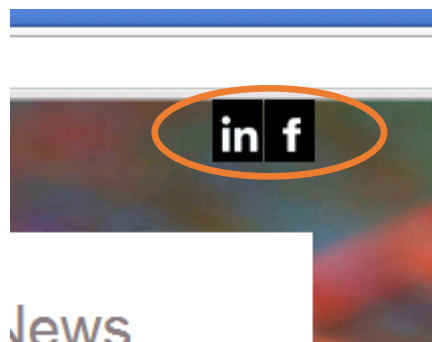


Fig. 13. The Social Media area of the BASTION web page
