#### 1. Summary description of the deliverable content and purpose

We installed a homepage on <a href="www.nanobits-project.eu">www.nanobits-project.eu</a> that will give a first informative impression of the project. A structured set-up from left to right enables a good introduction into complex project subjects. Menu listing and login form on the left side, a short text and a SEM-image in the center explain the main topic, and a calendar giving a project overview on the right side let the reader get interested to go into detail. The newly created NanoBits logo together with the EC and partner logos build the frame of the project topics and are important recognition factors.

With a personal login all registered consortium partners have access to the NanoBits partner area, where all confidential documents are stored into different directories. This serves as a library and archive as well as exchange of relevant documents. This category enables a good, efficient and an up-to-date cooperation and simplifies and shortens all work routines.

On the NanoBits website, all categories will be actualized and amended during the project run, so that the interested public and the people involved will get the latest project information and developments.

#### 2.1 NanoBits public website




Fig. 1: screenshot NanoBits Homepage

As shown on the screenshot above, the website <a href="www.nanobits-project.eu">www.nanobits-project.eu</a> presents at first a homepage beginning with the NanoBits logo and a picture of the bits themselves in the headline. Furthermore it contains a main menu with subtitles, a login form for project partners and a project description providing the background and goals of the project. All institute logos as well as the EU logo as the funding partner and the logo of the seventh framework programme are presented on the first page. A calendar for upcoming events, deliverable and milestone deadlines is helpful for the consortium to be reminded of the due dates.

The second subtitle NanoBits at a Glance introduces the participating partners in a star formation. Six rays lead to the consortium partners and demonstrate a short description of their qualities and tasks concerning the project.






Fig. 2: screenshot NanoBits At a Glance

#### 2.2 NanoBits confidential area




Fig. 3: screenshot NanoBits Partners Area
