1. Aim of this task

The objective of this task was, as in the case of workshop 1, to gather all the documentation arising from the workshops into one repository where all attendants of the event could download them and thus take part in the networking activities facilitated by NANO-TEC.

2. Work done

Right after the workshop ICN gathered the public version of the presentations, and prior to approval to publish them online, it uploaded them on the public area of the web platform. An example of this practice is given in *Figure 1*. Similarly, the NANO-TEC public mailing list started after workshop 1 with the names of the attendants who had agreed to have their contact details published was also updated with those of workshop 2. The link to download workshop 2 presentations and the updated contact list was circulated to the attendants of the second event by the end of October 2011. No corrective measure was needed as this was a straightforward action which had discrete reaction, as shown in the number of downloads, further increased after October 2011, as shown in *Figure 2*.
