The structure of the communication and dissemination of TAS³ is distributed on 4 different sites, each one addressing a specific target.






Home page of project partners' working space: November 2008

A training portal (http://training.tas3.eu/) has been developed in order to provide internal training (initially) then external training.






Home page of TAS³ training portal: November 2008


Home page of TAS³ community: November 2008
