### **Welcome to IREEN!**

Welcome to the first IREEN newsletter. We will be publishing more during the project to keep you up to date about the activity, outcomes and events related to the IREEN project. IREEN is a "Coordination Action" project supported by the European Commission.

The aim of such project is to promote and support the networking and coordination of research innovation activities at a European level, delivering a comprehensive strategy for European-scale innovation and take-up in the field of technology for energy efficiency.

The project will also deal with energy performance in large areas like neighbourhoods and extended urban/rural communities, examining ways in which energy-positive buildings - and by extension districts and neighbourhoods - can be developed (energy positive is the capacity to generate more power than needed by consuming low energy or consuming low energy over the "life-cycle" e.g. by green construction or for the transport of their users and occupants).

As well as identifying multi-disciplinary stakeholders and partnerships, looking at drivers and gaps, operational support and future policies, the project will develop an innovation roadmap which will link and prioritise actions through the innovation life-cycle:

- RTD (Research & Technological Development);
- · experimentation and validation;
- transfer to market and deployment;
- standardisation.

To achieve this, the project will draw on expertise from:

- the energy sector (both providers and distributors);
- the technology industry including appliance manufacturers, infrastructure and software technologists;
- the construction sector;
- the stakeholders from the demand side including local and regional authorities.

IREEN will also connect to smart cities partnerships across Europe and is funded under the EC's

<u>7th Framework Programme</u> as a Coordination and Support Action. The project started on 1st September 2011 for a duration of 24 months (until August 31st 2013).

The IREEN work programme will be developed within the overall context of the industrial and socio-economic trends and challenges faced by Europe.

Stakeholders are brought together under the IREEN umbrella to implement the project through:

- The project will host collaborative workshops on the continuous elaboration and
  assessment of the innovation strategy and roadmap with experts and stakeholders
  representing the entire value-chain: the energy sector, ESCOs, the technology industry,
  the construction sector, stakeholders from the demand side including local and regional
  authorities and NGOs. These will be engaging European and other international experts
  and stakeholders in both real and virtual hearings.
- 2. An Advisory Experts Group drawn from a wide variety of disciplines working across Europe will provide additional expertise. This group will work with the project consortium to validate the outcomes as well as acting as a catalyst for implementation.

- 4. The production and dissemination of results describing state of the art solutions and best practices, both supply side and demand-side visions and scenarios, along with step-by-step user-driven and business-oriented implementation plans.
- The assessment and validation of project results by stakeholder communities, prioritisation of research, experimentations and pilot projects, take-up and deployment in the market and standardisation activities.
