


Figure 6: Presentation of the consortium










Figure 7: Workplan description page




Figure 8: Contact us page

This section offers a description of the ICT-Emissions methodology for assessing the impact of advanced ICT -measures on transport.




Figure 9: Methodology description page




Figure 10: Exploitation group description page














Figure 11: Exploitation Group meetings page
