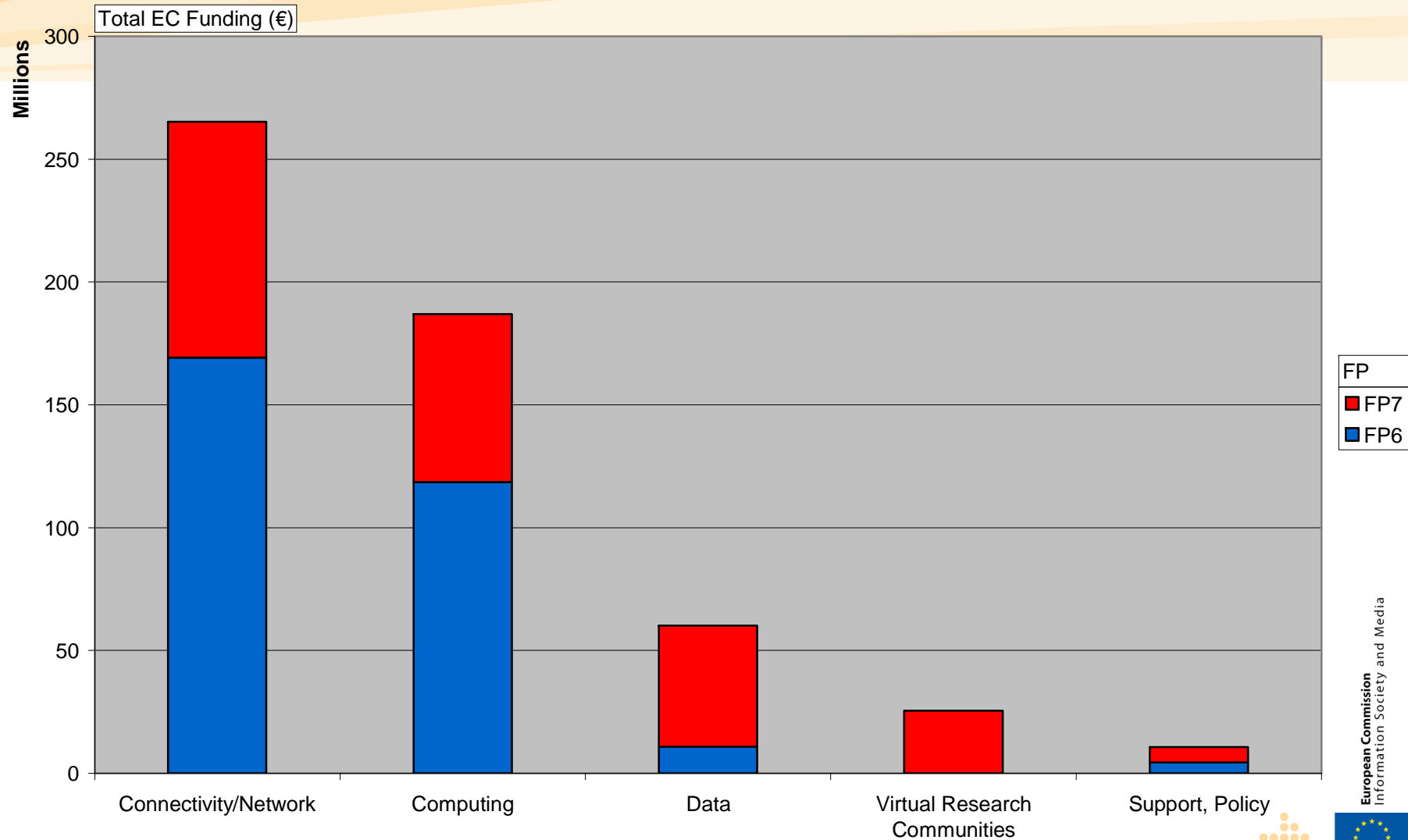

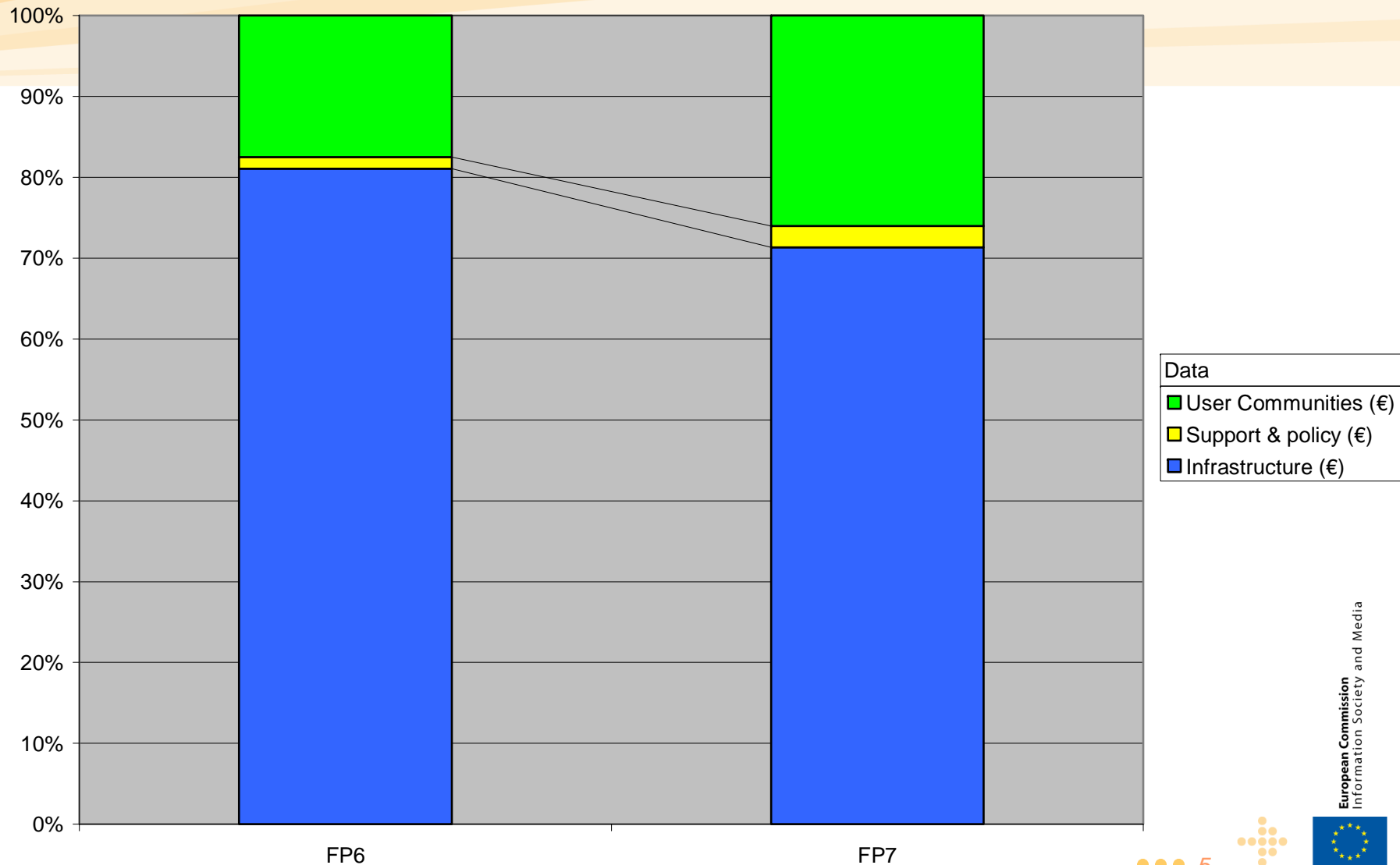
FP7 Budget Overview (2007-13)



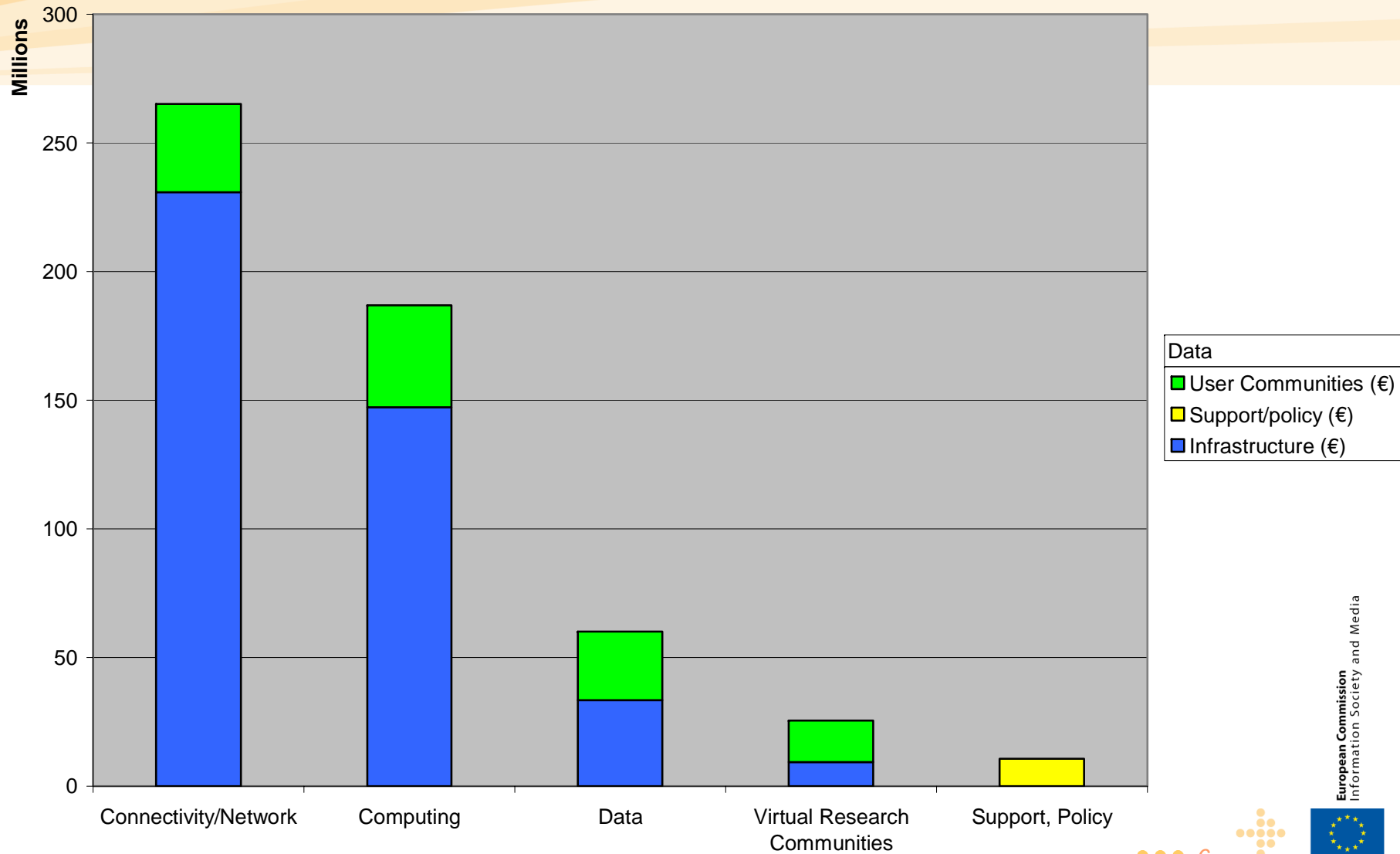
Funding per topic (FP6, FP7)



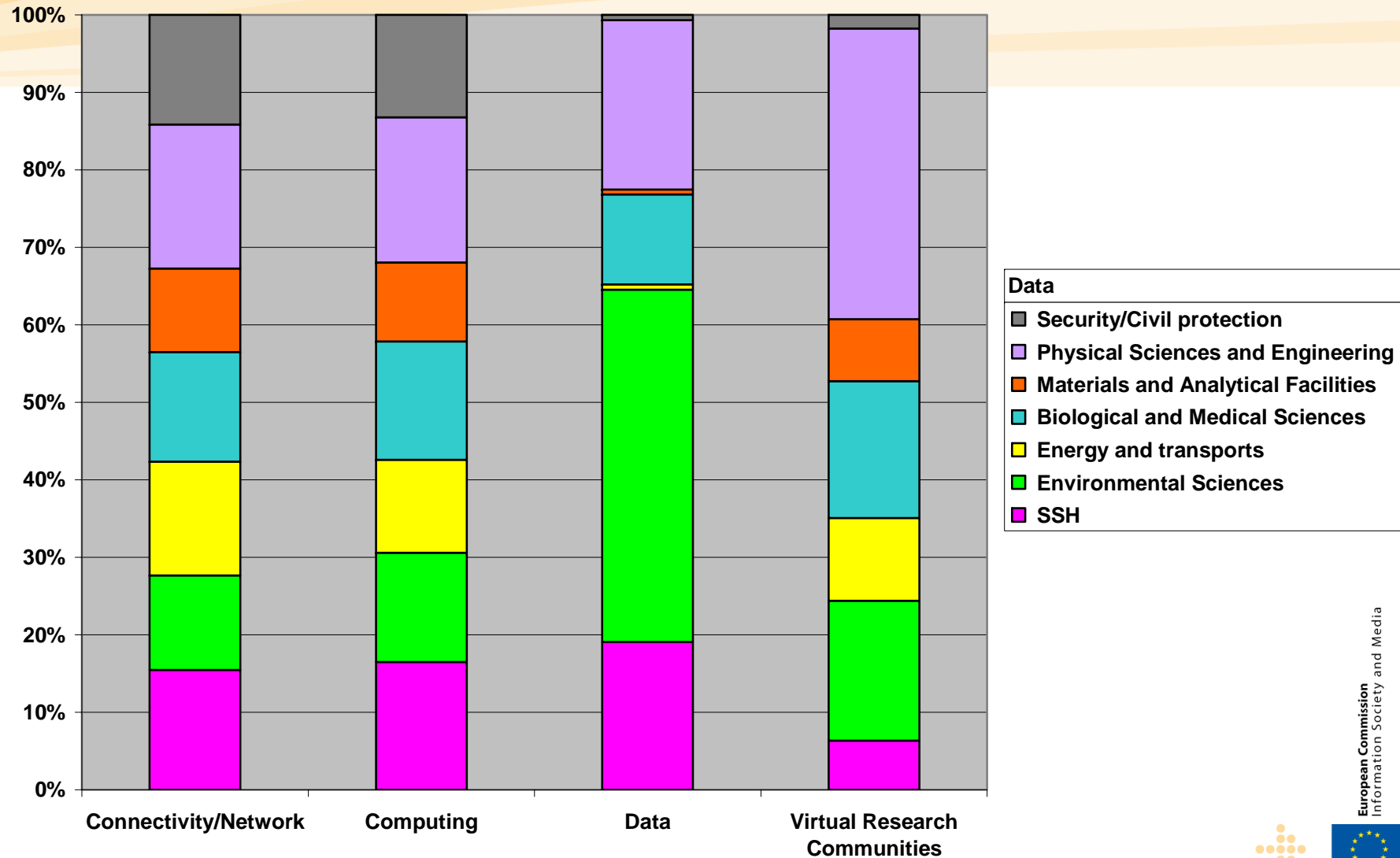
Support to Infrastructure vs support to user communities



Support to user communities per infrastructure layer

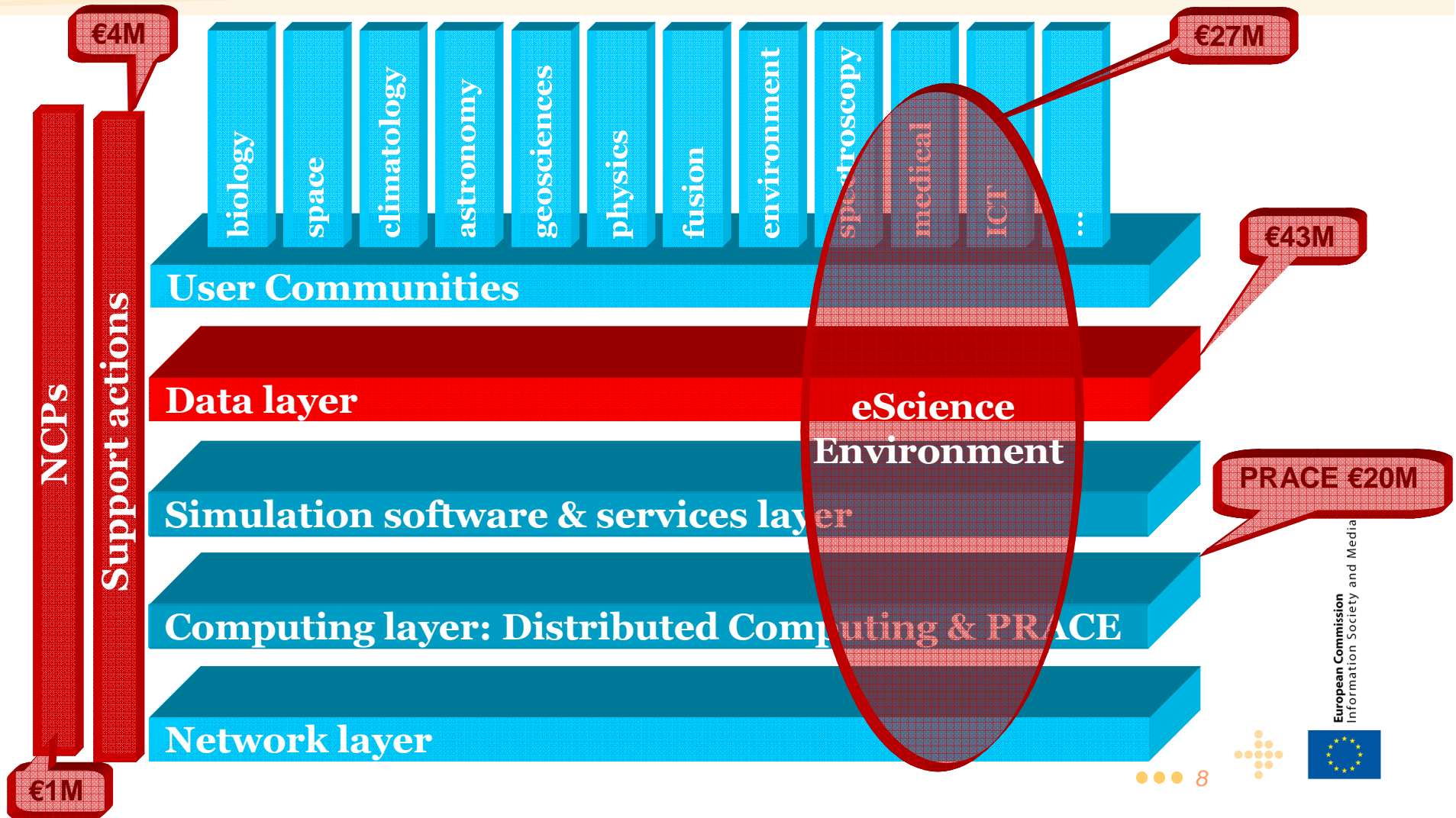


User community support per infrastructure layer

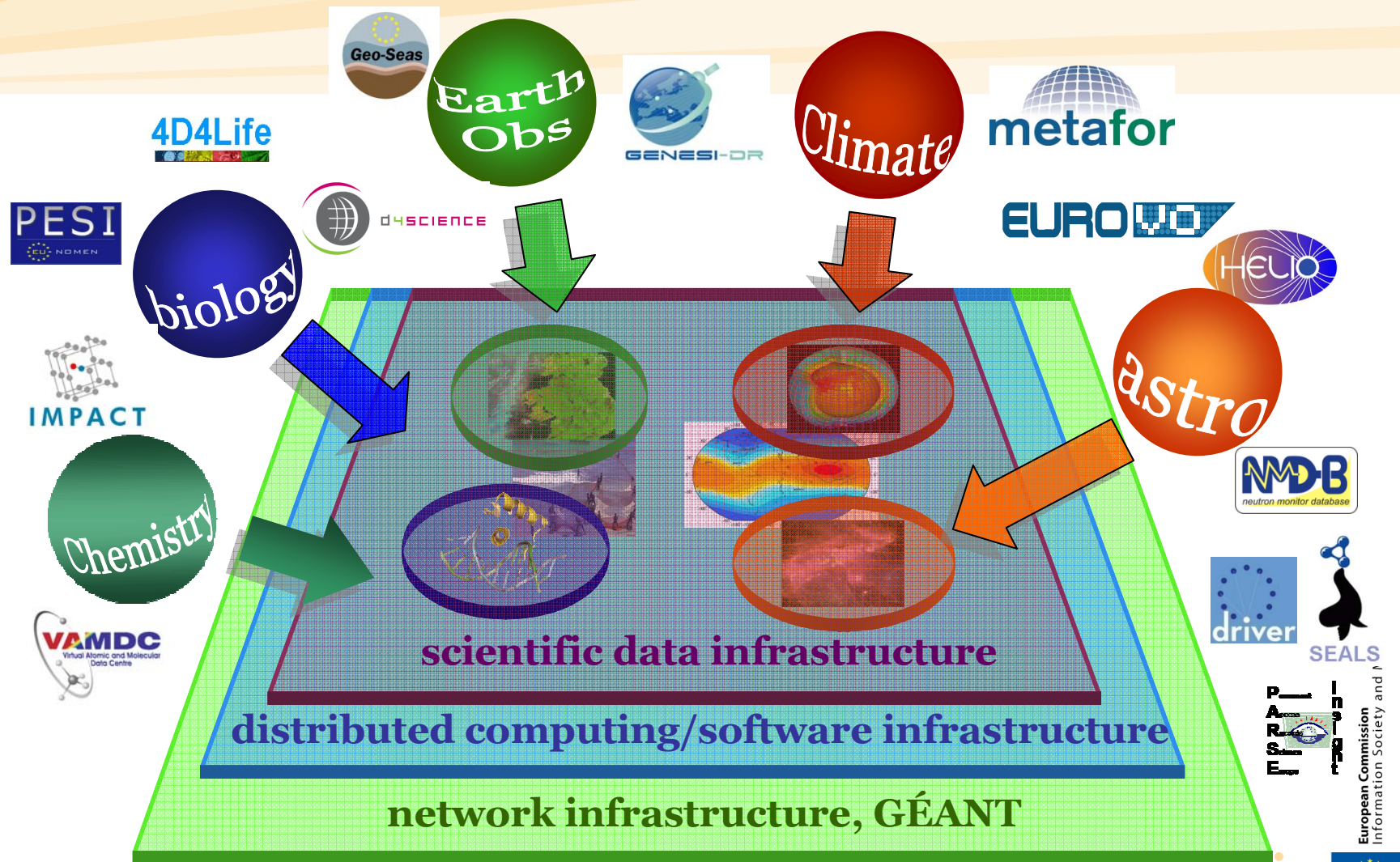
