Some suggestions

Better information about standards?

- ***Might Member States set up Standard Assessment Boards offering information about standards such as:***
 - how these standards were developed
 - what they offer
 - how they are used in the market

Possible models

- EU: CAMSS
- Dutch Standardisation Board & Forum

Which standards to use?

- *Might Member States set up advice centres to help individual procurers?*
- *Might they develop lists of recommended standards, perhaps requiring “use or explain why not” ?*
- *Should the use of open standards be required?*

Possible models

- NOiV hotline for procurers writing tenders
- Recommended lists:
 - Dutch (“Comply or explain open standards”)
 - Danish OIO Catalogue of Technical Standards with recommendation levels
 - Maltese Adopted Specification List
 - Forthcoming UK mandatory open standards

Business appraisal training?

- *Should there be more training for procurers and IT managers in business appraisal of ICT procurement decisions?*

Possible models

- A requirement for individual procurement officers/IT managers to be trained
 - Commercial training courses?
- A central training school or programmes

Moving away from legacy systems that create lock-in

- *Might Member States require public authorities to make formal assessment of risks of lock in?*
- *And to develop long term plan to get out of the “lock in”, using standards where relevant?*

Templates and ready text

- ***Might Member States develop templates e.g. for***
 - technology-neutral specifications
 - the referencing of standards
 - requesting licence conditions for sharing and re-use

Possible models

- German BITKOM specifications and benchmarks for some hardware
- Forthcoming UK 'end user device' strategy
- OSOR guidelines templates on referencing open standards
- OSOR recommendations for referencing EUPL in tenders

Sharing best practice

- ***EC to facilitate – or require! - exchange of experience and best practice, e.g.***
 - Successful migrations from legacy systems
 - Successful use of standards
- ***EC to provide a common platform for sharing resources***

- ePractice eProcurement Community
