Open calls: EU funding programmes

The ICT PSP Call 3 has been published recently, with a deadline of 2 June 2009. It continues the efforts of the eContentPlus programme that came to an end in 2008 and as such, complements the ICT programme of FP7.

Furthermore, as a reminder, the Lifelong Learning Programmes (e.g. Leonardo, Grundtvig, ICT and language horizontal actions) are currently open, with deadlines between 27 February and end of March 2009.

Last but not least, Call 4 of the ICT programme is open with a deadline of 1 April 2009.



e-Content Developers qualifications – a boost to employment



Lifelong Learning Programme – Calls 2009 open

This programme includes LEONARDO for vocational training, GRUNTVIG for adult education, as well as TRANSVERSAL actions (language, ICT, awareness raising) that must cover at least two of the LLP programmes. The deadlines are 27 February 2009 for Leonardo, Grundtvig, Comenius multilateral projects, networks and accompanying measures as well as for Leonardo transfer of Innovation projects; and 31 March 2009 for transversal projects.
