IST-AFRICA PORTAL

The IST-Africa portal (www.IST-Africa.org / www.ISTAfrica.eu) provides the platform for dissemination of the project results.

The IST-Africa 2010 site section was published in October 2009, with regular updates in relation to the Call for Papers, Advance Programme and Final Programme. The portal provides the tools for the online paper submission, remote double blind peer reviewing of papers, publication of feedback to authors, publication of the Programme, registration, submission of final papers and PPTs.

Following the IST-Africa 2010 conference, all delegates will be able to access and download the conference PPT presentations by logging in and going to the online programme.

All papers published in the IST-Africa 2010 Conference Proceedings will also be published in the IST-Africa Paper Repository. The Paper Repository is a research resource which is available to all members of the IST-Africa portal as well as the general public. The general public can search for relevant papers by thematic area or author. When they click on a link to access the PDF paper, they require a login to download the paper. There is no charge for registration or access to the Paper Repository. This ensures that the wider community who were not able to attend this year's conference still have access to the research results shared. All authors retain the copyright for their paper. In each case, the general public will have access a number of months after the conference, to encourage conference participation and networking. Existing members simply use their log in details when they wish to access the full paper. If a person is interested in reading a particular paper but is not already a member of the IST-Africa community, they simply enter their details via Mailing List and will automatically receive their username and password details by email. The Paper repository is available from all site sections.

Interested parties can submit their details via the mailing list to be included in updates sent to the Community. Regular updates are published on the conference and project site sections to keep the community informed of activities, opportunities for cooperation, upcoming events, newsletters and Calls for proposals.

Participants can register for the training workshops online.

The ICT Policy section provides a link to Policy documents as they are provided by the partner countries.

The Guide to Research Capacity provides an overview of the ICT environment, ICT Initiatives, research priorities and organisations involved in ICT activities in each country. This content is updated as new material is provided.

The Guide to FP7 is updated and republished based the publication of new Calls.
