1. Introduction

This deliverable is the outcome of the efforts of Task 6.2, in Workpackage 6 which concerns that dissemination of the public project outputs to policy making stakeholders. In particular, the efforts of this task focused on identifying existing and new policy making stakeholders and disseminating the project results to them on the course of the project. The consortium adopted a dissemination strategy founded upon the diversity of the consortium members; i.e. academic and commercial partners. The academic partners focused their efforts n disseminating UbiPOL to students (Bachelor, Msc, PhD. Degrees) and other academic members; in particular some of them had participated to the field trials and now have a personal experience of the system. Furthermore, all partners were involved in the strategic identification of local authorities that could use UbiPOL after its completion. Those efforts were very fruitful in Turkey, Portugal and the UK since several local authorities were engaged and expressed interesting in using UbiPOL; of course having different level of readiness for this. As part of this strategy all partners also strategically identified local authorities from other consortiums they belong to in EU projects. Finally, commercial partners made significant efforts to disseminate the projects' outputs to key market players enhancing the future exploitation of the results. The deliverable enlists the meetings that took place during the course of the UbiPOL project with the various policy makers along with the participants involved, the date and the topics of the meetings.

6. Conclusions

Disseminating the project results through academic publications and engagement of policy makers is essential for the future exploitation of the project's results. The current deliverable aggregates the efforts of the consortium towards the direction of customising UbiPOL towards the policy makers' requirements, identifying potential future users of the UbiPOL system and engaging key market players that can further promote the use of UbiPOL in the long term. Summarizing those efforts the consortium approached thirteen local authorities located in the UK, Turkey, Portugal, S. Korea, Japan, Italy and France. Moreover, a company from the market research industry and three companies from the telecommunications industry were approached. Although the results of the dissemination will be evident only in the long term, it is encouraging that many local authorities (including Pendik Municipality and Ankara Development Agency) have expressed their strong interest to use the system when it is publicly available.
