## 1. Introduction

### WHAT THIS SURVEY IS ABOUT:

If more than one person per content partner fills out this survey, discuss who will complete this final part regarding contributing metadata and content.

If you are not the person responsible for filling it out, you can skip this part and go to the end of the survey.
