Cooperative Cities extend and validate mobility services

What is Co-Cities?

Co-Cities is a pilot project to introduce and validate cooperative mobility services in cities and urban areas. It will develop a dynamic “feedback loop” from mobile users and travelers to the cities’ traffic management centres, allowing users to give feedback on received services as well as to provide new traffic information, which makes end-users part of the validation process of mobility services.

This “feedback loop” extension is based on the CAI.

What is the CAI?

The (In-Time) CAI, which is used and extended by **Co-Cities**, is a standardised, harmonised interface between operators and service providers (B2B interface). Different operators can continuously provide updated data which is then translated into a standard format. Traveller Information Service Providers (TISPs) have access to this data via the CAI and can use it to generate their mobility services.
