2 Progress and planning WP1 to 4

Every WP-leader gives a view about their WP and the planning of their WP. WP5 shows the overall planning of the tasks and reports which have to be deliverd of each WP-leader.

WP1 WP1

WP1 is almost, 99%, ready. There is a final discussion of task 1.6 Elke gives a presentation of 1.6 Requirements Smart Lighting Solutions. Albertslund (Denmark) is an interesting case, concerning the way of procurement. (follow up of the city under the microscope and the next meeting is 17 September 2014).

Process-proposal

After the market consultations there will be another meeting, organized by WP2,WP3 WP2 and WP3.

WP2 WP2

When the market consultations are finished, what happens next?

PCP-launch for 12 June:

All the information for this will be ready in the beginning of May. All the cities **Cities** have to evaluate the information and send this to the Commission. The Commission is just evaluating.

The cities need 2-3 weeks that their documents have to be approved. Reine will inform WP3 and the cities for the validation.

What have the cities to prepare? Which information will be ready and when?
WP3 only need the validation of the documents of the cities. |n the validation WP3
the cities will mention requirements they need.

There must be a cooperation between WP2, WP3 and the cities, so an interactive way of communication.

To help the cities Ramon (WP3) will make a checklist with important information for the cities.

WP3 need the information of all the cities in the beginning of May.
