WHAT IS HERITAGE PORTAL?

Heritage Portal is an online resource developed by the EU Net-Heritage Project* which focuses on European research applied to the protection of tangible cultural heritage. It consists of news, a database of articles, documents and datasets, and a social networking area.



WHAT DOES HERITAGE PORTAL DO?

- It provides detailed up-to-date news and information on European and national programmes, as well as research results.
- It disseminates the outcomes of the NET-HERITAGE project, including information on policy, funding, programmes and training related to cultural heritage.
- It acts as a virtual platform for users to disseminate their own content.
- It is unique in setting out to coordinate national Research and Technological Development (RTD) programmes of European countries in the field of heritage science research.

HOW CAN I ACCESS AND SIGN UP TO THE HERITAGE PORTAL?

You can access the Heritage Portal at: www.heritageportal.eu

To Sign up, just follow these simple steps:

- 1) Go to Social Tools tab and click on "Sign me up!" or on the Home page, go to the log in box (right-hand-side of page) and click on "Create a new account".
- 2) Fill in your name, username (you can make this up), email address and password. Add a short biography and upload a photo of yourself if you wish.
- 3) An activation link will be sent to your email address – click on (or copy and paste into your browser) the 'activation link' in the email to activate your account.
- 4) Sign-up complete! Now you can navigate around the site and also upload your own content. Just go to the Contribute tab and follow the instructions!
