

## Stacked applications of solutions – fast and brief compound application



1. Wash and compound solutions are subsequently aspirated in the pipette, where after the pipette directly moves to, and enters, the recording chamber



2. The stack is added in one go, whereas the cell first is exposed to the smaller compound zone (ca 30 µl) followed by the zone containing wash solution (ca 200 µl)
