COMPETITIVE FELLOWSHIPS TAILOR-MADE FOR CAREER DEVELOPMENT

AgreenSkills and AgreenSkills+ make the interests of their fellows a priority. Flexibility, combined with attractive salaries and conditions within first-rate research environments, define the programmes' core values.

Young researchers recruited as AgreenSkills fellows within one of Agreenium's laboratories receive a gross monthly salary of approximately € 3500, while salaries of independent researchers can reach up to € 5000. Salaries paid to AgreenSkills' fellows are significantly higher than those offered by the French state for similar positions.

Agreenium researchers selected for a postdoctoral fellowship abroad are awarded stipends in addition to the salary they continue to receive from their home institution.

The programmes are also geared

to supporting the **career development** of their fellows, and achieve this through the provision of tailor-made training packages with the help of a locally-appointed HR mentor.

AgreenSkills and AgreenSkills+ are coordinated by INRA (French National Institute for Agricultural Research) and Agreeniaum (French agricultural research and higher education consortium).

AgreenSkills' programmes fund mobility projects of both young experienced and independent researchers* from all over the world, without any restrictions on nationality.

"Incoming" fellowships aim to attract talented international researchers, from all disciplines, to develop basic, applied or targeted research projects within one of Agreenium's laboratories in France and its overseas departments and territories (260 labs, 800 research groups).

"Outgoing" fellowships are dedicated to Agreenium researchers who wish to develop similar projects within laboratories worldwide, outside France.

By supporting international mobility

fellowships, AgreenSkills benefits fellows, as well as their hosting laboratories, which are equally invested in the project's implementation and success. It provides excellent conditions to improve networking and international partnerships as well as research attractiveness in the fields of life, agricultural and environmental sciences.
