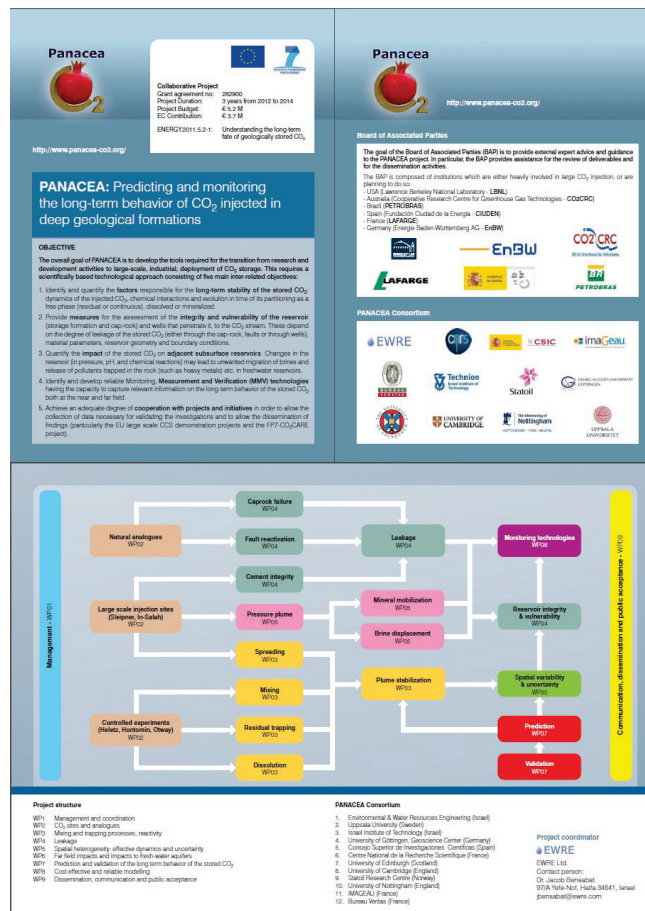


Figure 2: PANACEA flyer

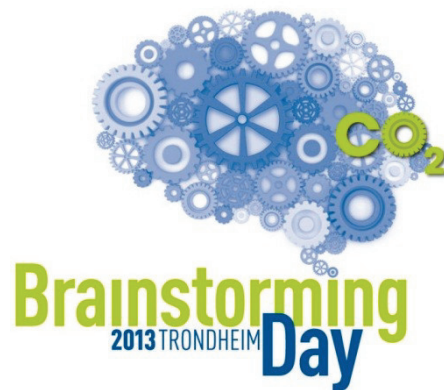


Figure 4: Logo of the Brainstorming Day
