




Anti-Imperial Metropolis

The Political Networks of
Africans, Asians, and Latin
Americans in Interwar Paris



Funded by the European Union through a Marie Curie Career Integration Grant, this project examines the political networks forged by Africans, Asians, and Latin Americans in Paris between the two World Wars. Its principal goal is to arrive at a better understanding of how these networks contributed to the construction of anti-imperial nationalisms on a global scale. It thereby aims at further complicating straightforward dichotomies between metropolitan and imperial/colonial history, as has been demanded by postcolonial scholars over the last decades.
