Figure 1: Map of the first fieldwork stage (Work Package 3)

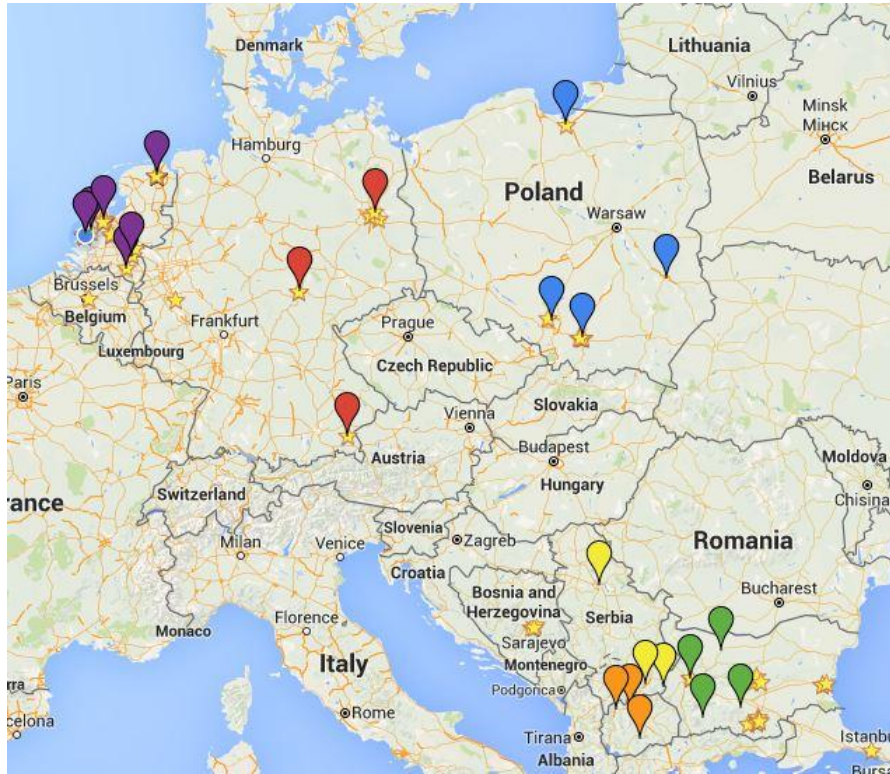


Figure 2: Map of the second fieldwork stage (Work Package 3)
