Project objectives

The project aims at stimulating young people's interest in a science career by producing four TV-programmes on the impact of science on the future society. They will deal with the impact of science on the future society. The TV-programmes will be widely broadcasted in Europe and they will be available to the education sector.

The objectives of the project are:

- 1) Showing the young people unfamiliar with science how science will influence their future living conditions. The TV-programmes will aim at stimulating the curiosity of young people and visualise different scenarios of their future living conditions.
- 2) **Creating acceptance of public funding of science**. The TV-programmes will help the young generation to understand that public investment in science is necessary to strengthen Europe in the global competition.
- 3) Strengthening the dialogue between scientists, politicians and the civil society. The TV-programmes will visualise future scenarios and highlight the solutions needed to realise them. The TV-programmes will underline the importance of feedback from the civil society to the scientists and the politicians by showing young people confronting politicians and scientists with their ideas and ambitions.
- 4) Encourage young people to select a scientific career
