Project description

From cooperative herding groups to hierarchical societies

What do we know about nomadic empires? Can we explain the transition of cooperative pastoralist groups to complex organisations? The livestock (as the primary source of wealth) is believed to reduce inequalities and prevent pastoralism of supporting hierarchical societies. However, there is evidence that environmentally induced livestock losses sharpen wealth inequalities. The EU-funded COMPLEXITY project will develop a theoretical explanation of political organisation from acephalous societies in Africa to imperial confederations in Inner Asia by perceiving cooperative herding groups as the building blocks of nomadic societies. The project will cross-culturally document the prevalence of cooperative herding groups, investigate how

evolutionary factors impact pastoral cooperation and how cooperation affects pastoral performance and inequality.
